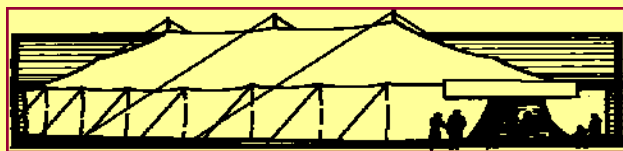

Plan to come next weekend and have a great time with your friends and neighbors!



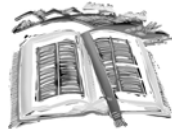

THE PASTOR'S BLOG

The articles of organization of our new Christ the King Parish Endowment have been approved by the diocese and returned to us. Thanks to Attorney Joan Eads who wrote the document.

The articles establish an endowment committee who acts "as advisor to the Fund Administrator and as a developer of the Fund." The committee has three directives: 1) increase the funds assets; 2) eventually increase the principle so that income can be contributed to the parish; and 3) solicit a variety of assets such as financial assets, real and personal property, beneficiary of trusts, wills, and life insurance.

I have asked three extremely able people to be the members of the endowment committee: Bob Dombroski, Patrick Kennedy and Roy Neuenschwander. They have all graciously accepted membership.

Contributions to endowments are never spent. Only income from investments is spent for "the welfare of the Parish." We hope to tell you about some of the ways that everyone can contribute to the endowment. Thanks to the first three members of the endowment committee for doing the pioneering work.

Next weekend is King Fest. This event involves the greatest number of parish members working on a single project. The committee has been working hard to bring new ideas to King Fest. Many of you have volunteered. Some have not volunteered, but I hope they actively participate by attending some of the many events of King Fest.

Every five years our parish presents a pictorial directory and this is that year. You may already register on-line for your appointment at our parish website, www.myparish.com or register after Masses three weekends. Our consultant from Olan Mills commented that our staff (except for the maintenance person) is exactly the same as it was five years ago. Parish staffs generally do not stay intact that long. Staff members have asked if they could include their pictures from 2005. Even though I have a few added wrinkles since then, I think it best to take new pictures.

I look back at former directories and see folks who have passed away, see children who have grown up over the years, and see changes in parish activities. They are like family albums. Families tend not to take formal portraits for a variety of reasons. I know many times a church pictorial directory has been the last time a family portrait has been taken before a member would die suddenly. The last formal picture of my parents was an Olan Mills portrait taken at their parish in Florida.

The portraits will be taken in the meeting rooms from 2:00 – 9:10 P.M. Monday through Friday, and from 9:30 A.M. - 5:10 P.M. on Saturdays.

Each family photographed will receive a free 8x10 portrait and a free directory. Fr. Steve will be happy to photograph those who are physically unable to come to church. You will also have the opportunity to register after Masses on the weekends of August 28-29, September 11-12 and September 18-19.



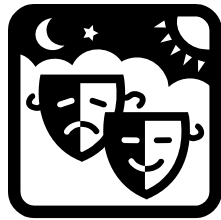
Anyone Interested?

New This Year ... Art and Essay Contest

The Social Concerns Committee invites all students in Grades K-8 to participate in an art and essay contest. The theme for the contest will be "Discipleship: Called to Help Others". Students are asked to explore how living their faith can make a difference in the lives of those in need.

Students in Grades K-1 should draw a picture that shows how they can help others with something they need or want, but can't always get for themselves.

Students in Grades 2-5 may either draw a picture that includes a written description or write an essay (about one page) about ways to help those in need.

Students in Grades 6-8 will write an essay up to 500 words about what "Social Concerns" means in Catholic teaching.

All submissions are due to the parish office (hard copy only; no email submissions please!) by October 10 and should include the name of the student. Entries will be judged by educators from the parish and prizes will be awarded for each age group. For students in grades K-5, a \$50 donation will be made in the child's name to one of the following charities of their choice: St. Vincent DePaul ministry, McFarland Food Pantry, Luke House, Catholic Multi-Cultural Center, San Alfonso Mission, Pennies for Pillows. For students in grades 6-8, a \$50 donation will be made in the child's name to the child's choice of one of the listed charities OR \$50 will be placed in an account that child may use for CTK Youth Ministry activities including retreats and mission trips.

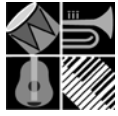
