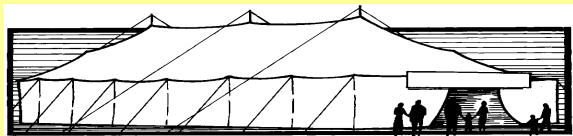

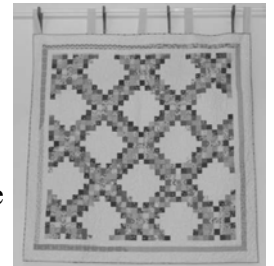

## FROM THE PASTOR

We are sad to announce that Cindy Weber has resigned her position as administrative assistant. For two years Cindy has been very active as a part-time staff person in many administrative aspects of the parish. Thanks, Cindy!

Our new administrative assistant will be Tracy Kurt. She is presently working part-time as parish secretary/business manager at St. Patrick Parish in Cottage Grove. She uses the same data base and accounting programs that we use so her transition should be smooth. Tracy will be working on Fridays here at Christ the King and Monday through Thursdays at St. Pat's. She will begin next Friday.

Tracy was seeking more hours than she received at St. Pat's. Since St. Pat's will be linked with us within the next two years, she will establish a good relationship with our parish staff.

Tracy is married and has four grade school age children. She and her husband farm near Deerfield. As we say "good-bye" to Cindy (as a parish staff member, but she and family are not moving!), we want to welcome Tracy to our parish staff.

Next weekend will be King Fest. This annual parish festival involves more parish members than any other non-liturgical event. It also raises funds for our parish youth ministry program. This year 10 percent of the profit will go toward the re-opening of the Catholic Multicultural Center in Madison.

There have been some very exciting developments in this re-opening. Led by Our Lady Queen of Peace Parish in Madison, a significant level of funding has been arranged. Even the City Council in Madison has given a grant. The greater the profit from King Fest, the greater will be our gift to the Multicultural Catholic Center.

One of the sources of income for HarvestFest and ReunionFest (names of the previous parish festivals) has been gifts from local businesses. One business decreased their gift from \$1500 to \$200 citing economic reasons. Other local businesses have decreased or even stopped their gifts this year because of economic woes. In order to equal – and hopefully increase – previous year's profits and to help the Multicultural Catholic Center, we need the help of everyone to sell raffle tickets and to be involved in the activities of King Fest.

I have often been asked whether parish festivals are about money or parishioner participation. Of course the answer is both. Over the six years of recent parish festivals we have raised around \$90,000 from which grants have been given to local, non-parish causes. But many relationships have begun by parishioners meeting and working together with other parishioners whom they previously did not know. This is definitely a win-win event.

**Protecting God's Children  
Adult Awareness Session**

We will hold a Protecting God's Children Adult Awareness Session on August 30, from 11:00 A.M. to 1:00 P.M. All adults working with children in our parish are required to have attended a session. If you plan to volunteer in any activity with children and have not attended a session, please register for this one. To register, go to [www.Virtus.org](http://www.Virtus.org) and click on the Registration link. If the class at CTK does not work with your schedule, you may view all sessions available in the Madison diocese and choose one that works for you.



As adults, we are all responsible for keeping our children safe from child sexual predators. These sessions help attendees understand the techniques predators use to entice children, and concrete ways to stop them. While required for any adult in the parish who works with children, the class is recommended for every adult in the parish.

Feedback from previous sessions has consistently told us that although it is challenging for participants to find time in their busy lives to attend a meeting, once they have done so, they are grateful that they did. ### **It Is Time to Register for Religious Education!**

Pre-K students are those children who will be age 4 by September 1, 2009. Confirmation students are those beginning their junior year of high school.

Families without children in the home may use the same form to register for Generations of Faith.

### **Catechists Needed!**

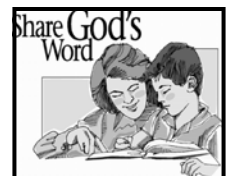
